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- a. Wrapping up last day of 2019 dive semester. Taught 14 divers who came to Sitka. Total dives (790 dives) Open water and Advanced and Rescue and Scientific Diving. Wrapping up the internship. Instead of 1 project they had 3 projects on the invasive tunicate: assess level of efficacy of treatments for eradication. Mapping could be improved. Another project was kelp ecosystems. Lastly, teamed with city and harbor master to clean up harbor. One student completed over 100 dives during the semester.

Lessons learned: some students could not complete the swim tests even though they were open water divers. They were not able to take the course. Now some of these students are working at ADFG. Jared taking a student.
