- a. The VCAS will continue to work with all VCs to determine what building use can be consolidated or suspended to find savings.
- b. The VCAS will proactively work to reduce UAF's footprint by demolishing facilities that have a ratio of deferred maintenance to replacement cost of higher than 0.65. Five buildings are currently slated for demolition approval.
