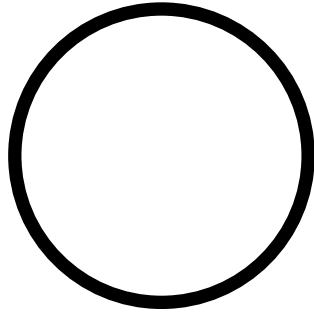


Red, yellow, and blue play dough*, Color Wheel template. *Optional:* Pencil.

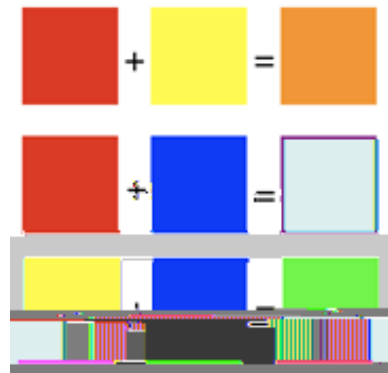

Start with a piece of dough from each of the primary colors (

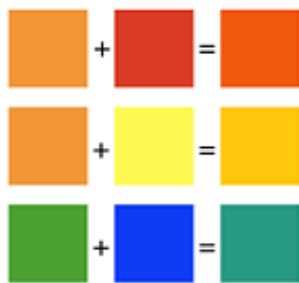


Some materials let certain colors pass through them, and absorb other colors. These materials are called dyes or pigments. The primary colors of pigment are red, yellow, and blue. The secondary colors can be mixed to create other colors.

A secondary color + a primary color = a tertiary color. The tertiary colors are orange, green, and purple.



You can mix secondary colors with primary colors to make tertiary colors. The tertiary colors are orange, green, and purple.
