## Explore the Moon!

Go outside to observe the moon every night for a month. Record what you see in a Moon Observation Journal.

Materials Needed:

Printable Moon Observation Journal  
([moon.nasa.gov/resources/12/moon-observation-journal](https://moon.nasa.gov/resources/12/moon-observation-journal)),  
pencil, warm clothes.

Instructions:

Step 1: Print the Moon Observation Journal, or make your own.

Step 2: Go outside each night and observe the moon. Fill out the chart according to the instructions. What do you notice? Did anything surprise you?

## Explore the Snow!

Collect snowflakes on black paper and observe the patterns and shapes.

Materials Needed:

A snowy day, black paper, warm clothes.  
Camera or phone to take pictures.

Instructions:

Step 1: Go outside on a snowy day. Make sure to wear warm clothes, and bring a sheet of black paper.

Step 2: Hold up the black paper and let snow fall on it. The contrast of the white snow against the black paper will allow you to see the snowflakes clearly.
